GENERAL INFORMATION

Perfector may be used to enhance the efficacy of agricultural chemicals as it improves penetration into the leaves. Perfector may be used to prevent hydrolysis of pesticides that are sensitive to high pH (acidifier).

Perfector is compatible with most common pesticide formulations.

Before tank mixing, a jar test using the exact ratio of the proposed mixture is recommended using the exact ratio to ensure compatibility.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Perfector is suitable for a variety of crops including fruit and vegetable crops, ornamentals, turf and grassland, right-of-way (railroads and roadsides) and industrial sites. Consult and follow pesticide manufacturer's label for recommended rates of adjuvant.

Do not exceed adjuvant level of 5% of the finished spray volume unless specified by the pesticide label.

Highly alkaline water ($\geq$ pH 8) 70-150ml/100L of spray mixture.

Mildly alkaline/acid water (pH 6-8) 30-70ml/100L of spray mixture.

Herbicides, defoliants & desiccants	100-600ml
Insecticides, Fungicides, PGR & foliar nutrients	50-400ml
Non-crop sites	0.1-1.5L
Turf and ornamentals	100-600ml

NOTE: Before treating large areas, test on a small area and observe prior to scale application

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PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

Causes serious eye damage. Causes skin irritation. May cause respiratory irritation. Read label before use. Avoid breathing mist/vapour/spray. Wear protective gloves and eye protection/face protection. Wash hands and exposed skin thoroughly after handling. Use only outdoors or in a well-ventilated area.

ENVIRONMENTAL PRECAUTIONS

Prevent further leakage or spillage if safe to do so. Do not contaminate water. Do not allow to enter drains, sewers, or watercourses.

STORAGE

Store locked up. Store in a well-ventilated place. Store above 0°C, in cool, dry place. Store in original container. Keep tightly closed. Do not reuse empty container. Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

TRANSPORT

Not classified as a hazardous substance for transport.

SPILLAGE

Exclude all bystanders from the vicinity of the spill and prevent material from entering waterways. Wear appropriate protective clothing as in the personal protection section of this label to clean up spills. Absorb spills with an inert material (such as vermiculite, earth, sand or synthetic absorbent substance) and place in waste containers. Wash area thoroughly and absorb any remaining liquid with further inert material. Dispose of the waste safely in an approved landfill.

DISPOSAL

Dispose of product by using according to label directions or disposing to an approved waste disposal facility. Triple rinse empty container (or equivalent) adding rinse water to spray tank. Offer container for recycling or dispose of container in sanitary landfill, or by other procedures approved by appropriate authorities.

FIRST AID
